According to the knowledge gap hypothesis, 'as the infusion of mass media information into a social

system increases, segments of the population with higher socioeconomic status tend to acquire this information at a faster rate than lower status segments, so that the gap in knowledge between these segments tends to increase rather than decrease' [(Tichenor et al., 1970), pp. 159-160].
